

TOWN OF ALTONA
BY-LAW NO. 1626/2005

Being a By-law to control and regulate the placing of signs in the Town of Altona.

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and expedient to control and regulate certain signs in the Municipality;


NOW THEREFORE BE AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT, no person or persons shall post or cause to be posted up any signs or notices exceeding 30 inches in height.
2. THAT, no person or persons shall attach any sign or notice to any Traffic control sign or public structure.
3. THAT, no person or persons shall place any sign within 50 feet of any intersection within the Town of Altona.
4. Any sign or notice may be placed on public property without written permission of the Town of Altona, providing that such sign(s) are not placed on such public property for a period of more than Five (5) consecutive days (subject to Section 5 of this By-law.) Any person(s) wishing to place a sign on public property for a period exceeding Five (5) consecutive days must first obtain written permission from the Town of Altona to do so and if permission is granted the period of time that such a sign may remain posted shall be stated in writing by the Town of Altona.
5. Any sign or notice posted up shall be removed within 24 hours of the expiration of the event to which the Notice refers, by the person or persons posting or causing such sign or notice to be posted up.
6. THAT, any person or persons violating any provision of this By-law shall be subject to a Fine of in accordance with the provisions of the Town of Altona Fines and Penalties By-law.
7. THAT this By-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passing thereof.
