Altona Cemetery Columbarium

Altona, MB. October 1, 2024:

The Town of Altona has completed several key upgrades at the Altona Cemetery, including the installation of a new columbarium and successful hydroseeding.

Established in 1948, the Altona Cemetery is located just south of the town in the Municipality of Rhineland. As a key part of Altona's heritage, the Town remains dedicated to preserving and enhancing the cemetery for future generations. These improvements mark a significant step in ensuring the cemetery continues

to meet the community's needs while enhancing its long-term sustainability and aesthetic appeal.

The columbarium, located in the new expansion of the cemetery, stands as a 7-foot-tall, 3.5-foot-wide solid granite structure. It contains 48 niches, each measuring 12"x12"x12". These niches, now available for purchase, provide a respectful and secure resting place for loved ones. The cost for a columbarium niche is \$2,500 plus GST, with an additional opening and closing fee of \$250 plus GST. The purchase and installation of the columbarium were accounted for in the Town of Altona's 2024 Financial Plan, with a total cost just under \$25,000, staying within the budget for the project.

In addition to the columbarium installation, hydroseeding was conducted to address a failed seeding attempt from last fall in the new expansion area. Hydroseeding, a more effective alternative to traditional seeding, involves spraying a mixture of seed, mulch, water, and fertilizer over the soil. This method promotes better soil-to-seed contact, increasing the likelihood of successful growth, even in challenging environmental conditions. The success of the hydroseeding became evident just weeks after the initial application, with the area now boasting fully established grass.

Looking ahead, the Town of Altona is considering additional work at the cemetery this fall. Potential projects include applying another lift of road gravel and installing an additional row of headstone ribbons. These enhancements reflect the Town's commitment to ongoing cemetery improvements. Future plans include further road upgrades and adding more greenery along with a sitting area near the columbarium. Long-term, the Town intends to develop a comprehensive landscape design to adequately plan and maintain the cemetery's beauty for generations to come.
