PLUM COULEE February 2026 POLICE ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

On the 9th of February Police were called to a motor vehicle collision where a vehicle had driven through a fence. Plum Coulee Fire also attended. No injuries were reported.

On the 18th of February Police were called to assist the local ambulance for an adult in distress. An ambulance attended from Boundary Trails and the adult female was transported to hospital.

On the 17th of February Police attended to the Plum Coulee School in order to discuss internet safety presentations that are available to the school. Police also conducted a walk through the school

On the 19th of February Police were called by a concerned citizen that a female in Plum Coulee maybe attempting to harm themselves by taking pills. The caller advise that the female had sent him a photo of her hand full of pills. Police attended and determined there was no desire to self harm, and that the female had just sent a photo of the actual pills she needs to take, as prescribed by a physician.

On the 24th of February Police received a complaint of harassment from a resident of Plum Coulee. The male advised that during the course of their profession they were providing assistance to another person, when a third party began to inject themselves into the process, and began to harass the complainant. Police provided advice to the complainant, as that is all they were seeking at this point.
