PLUM COULEE AUGUST 2026 POLICE ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

On the 1st of August Police received a call from a resident of Plum Coulee who advised he had received a threat from a person he knows. The Suspect advised that when he gets back to Manitoba he would kill the victim. Police spoke to both parties, and mediated the dispute.

On the 2nd of August Police were called to a hydro pole fire by the CO OP gas station. Police attended, and Plum Coulee Fire was already on scene. Mb hydro was coming to fix a fuse. Scene left in the hands of Plum Coulee Fire.

On the 5th of August, Police were called to an apartment complex in Plum Coulee. The complainant advised there are cameras in the common area where some residents are served meals. A male is seen going through the fridge and cabinets. Police recognized the male as a resident, and spoke to the male. He advised the door to the kitchen was open, so he went in looking for food, as he was hungry. The 42 yr old male from Plum Coulee was warned.

On the 13th of August Police received a complaint of an erratic driver in Plum Coulee. Police located the vehicle, and upon speaking with the driver, could detect the presence of liquor. The driver produced two breath samples on an approved screening device, which produced a reading of “fail”. The driver was issued with an Immediate Roadside Suspension. MPIC driver and vehicle licencing to follow up with action on the driver.

On the 25th of August Police received a fraud complaint from Plum Coulee. The complainant advised that they thought they were dealing with a member of the Corn and Apple Festival committee, and e-transferred \$330 for a booth rental. The complainant did not receive any confirmation email on the rental, and contacted the committee member via phone. It was learnt at this point that no money had been received, and that the communication the complainant had was through a fraudulent site.
