

WELCOME TO THE ALTONA PARK CAMPGROUND

We hope you enjoy your stay in Altona and have fun at our recreational facilities!

The Altona Park features:

- Asphalt trails for walking, jogging, biking or rollerblading
- Baseball diamonds & Tennis Courts - bring your own equipment
- Outdoor volleyball courts - bring your own volleyball
- Picnic shelters
- Playground
- Washroom & Shower Facilities
- Our Altona Aquatic Centre - 35,000 square feet of fun.
(Aquatic Centre admissions are not included with camping fees)

The adjacent Buffalo Creek Nature Park has trails that are lit at night, and catch & release fishing 7 days a week!

Our campground features 30 sites with 30 amp electricity and water hook-up. Please check in at the pool/campground office before setting up your campsite



Following are a few campground regulations to ensure that everyone can enjoy their stay:

- Check-out time is 1:00 p.m. The site must be completely cleared at this time.
- Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. Please check in at the Aquatic Centre.
- Please do not move picnic tables or fire pits out of the campsites. Only one picnic table & fire pit per site.
- Only one family is allowed per site
- Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. through to 7:00 a.m. This includes turning off generators during this time. Pool/campground staff are not on duty at these times, but if problems arise the Altona Police Department can be contacted at 324-5353, 24 hours a day. (A payphone is available on the north exterior of the pool building)
- The Aquatic Centre regulations are posted; please remember that all patrons must wear bathing suits. No cut-offs, thongs or inappropriate attire allowed.
- Pets must be leashed at all times. Owners are responsible for clean-up of droppings.
- Please remember that there are recycling bins and garbage cans located throughout the Altona Park.
