ALTONA'S CHANGES DUE TO CRITICAL (RED) ZONE ANNOUNCEMENT

Altona, MB. November 6, 2020:

As of Monday, November 9th, 2020, the Southern Health-Santé Sud health region is moving into Critical (Red) on the Pandemic Response System. In response, the Town of Altona has made a few changes.

As of Saturday, November 7th, 2020, the Millennium Exhibition Centre and the Rhineland Pioneer Centre will be closed to the public, as required by public health orders. Those who had bookings scheduled will be contacted. Recreation programming will also be suspended until further notice.

As of Monday, November 9th, the Town of Altona Administration Office will again close to the public, as it did in March. Residents can continue to access services from the office by calling 204-324-6468, through the website, or by emailing info@altona.ca.

These measures are being taken with the safety of our staff and community in mind, and in compliance with public health orders. The Town staff will continue to be hard at work delivering essential services, and keeping the community connected and informed.
