The public reserve to be closed is described as follows:

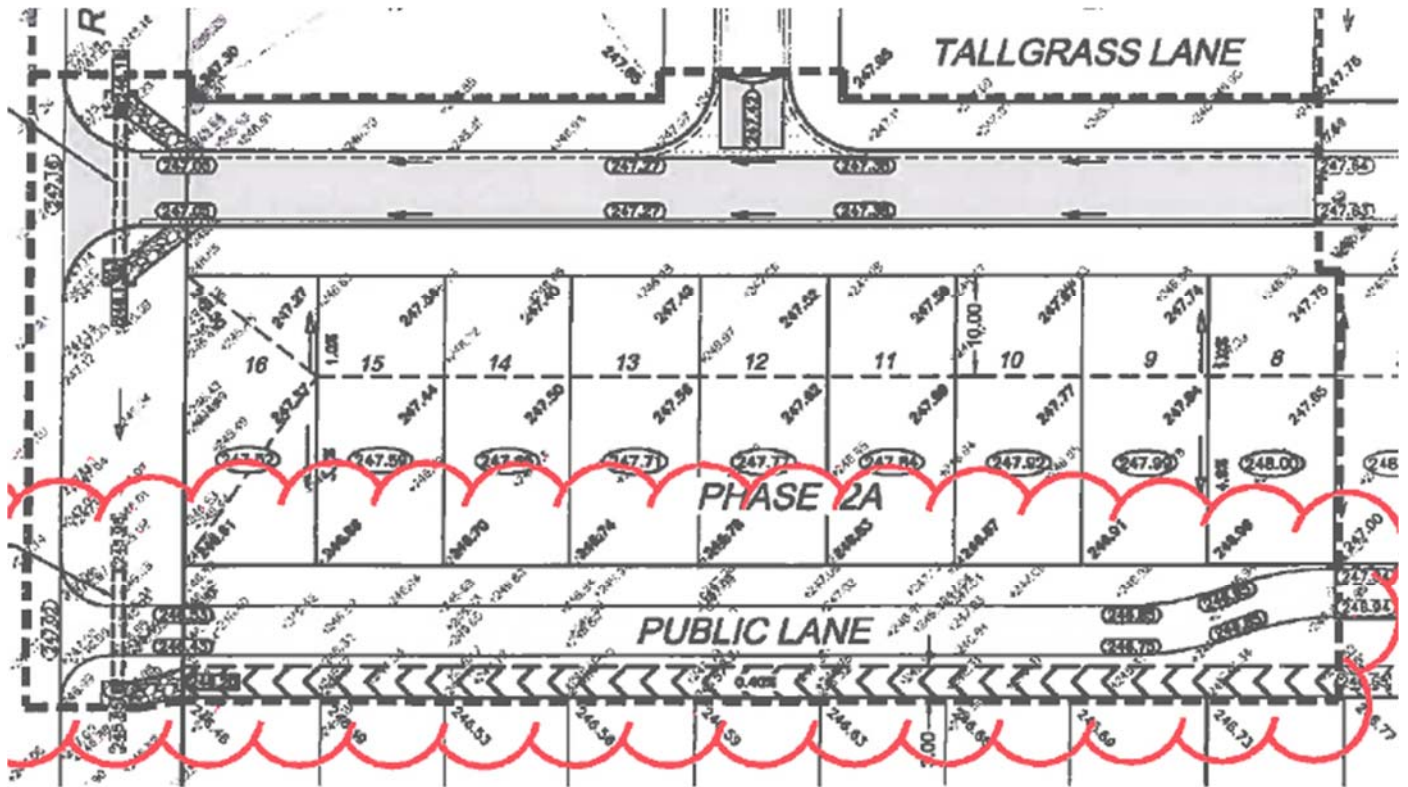
All that portion of Public Reserve, Plan No. 53289 MLTO contained within the limits of a Plan of Public Lane prepared by Albert Gerhard Degner, of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 23rd day of November, 2020, Plan No. _____ (Deposit 1352/2020) MLTO in the NW ¼ Section 8 Township 2 Range 1 WPM;

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that Council will, at the time and place aforesaid, hear any person or by his or her agent, any person who claims that his or her land will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. The Plan of Public Lane referred to above may be viewed by appointment only at the Municipal Office, 111 Centre Avenue East, Altona, Manitoba, on any weekday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12 noon and 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.
