Compostable Materials



- There is no limit to the amount of compostable material that can be put out for collection per household. All compostable materials should be placed inside a:
- Green compost cart (maximum weight of 130 lbs/cart).
 - Containers with molded handles without lids (maximum weight of 50 lbs/container).
 - Compostable bags, such as paper yard waste bags, (maximum weight of 35 lbs/bag).

If your container includes non-compostable materials or branches it will not be collected.

Compost carts are numbered and must remain at the property to which they are assigned.

Recyclable Materials



There is no limit to the amount of recycling that can be put out for collection per household. For pick up at the curb, all recycling materials should be placed in:

- Blue recycling cart
- Any container that is clearly marked as recycling

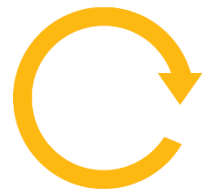
Recycling Carts are numbered and must remain at the property which they are assigned.

Garbage Collection



Residential dwellings are allowed 1 Garbage Bag or Container (30 Gallons / 114 Litres) per week. Any bags above the limit must have a garbage bag tag. Garbage bag tags are available for \$2 each and may be purchased at the Altona Civic Centre. As per Workplace Health & Safety regulations, all garbage bags or containers must weigh less than 50 pounds.

Waste Diversion Loop



Items that can be dropped off FREE of charge during Landfill hours at the Waste Diversion Loop (just inside the Waste Disposal Site entrance):

- Tires
- Mattress / box spring
- Metal
- Propane Tanks
- Batteries
- Appliances (Fridge, Freezers & Stoves)



Automobile Oil, Oil Filters, used cooking oil, Coolant, & Consumer DEF containers (4L) can be brought to our Used Oil Recycling Depot!

Yard Waste Site is just west of the Waste Disposal Site entrance.
